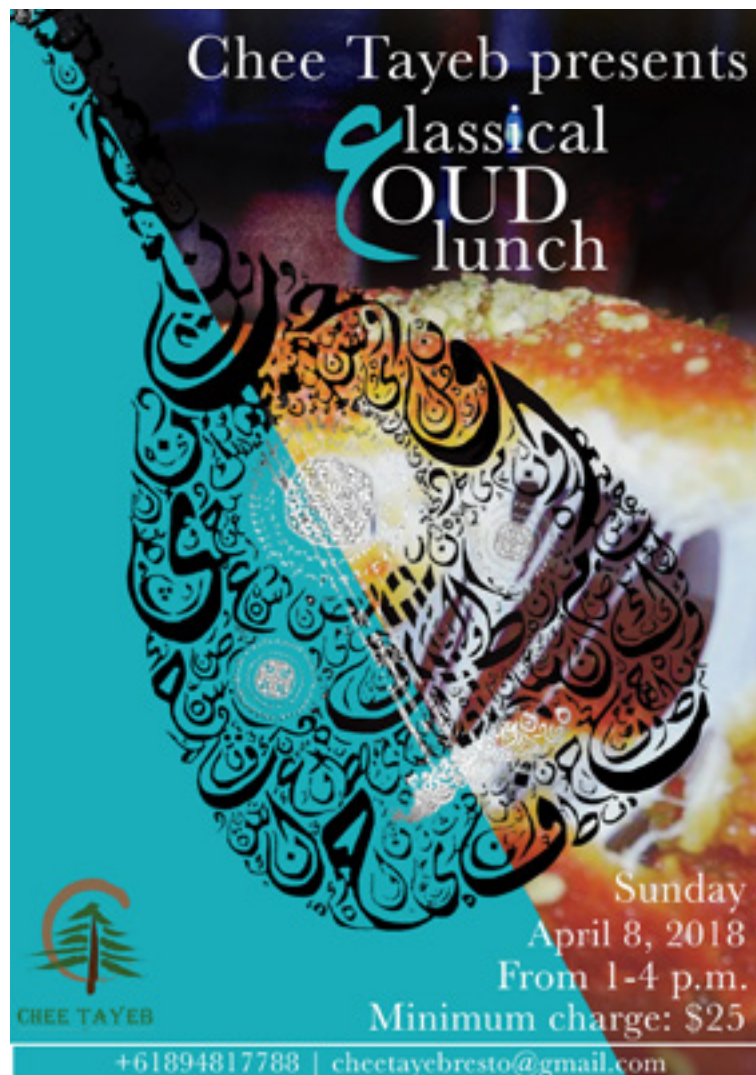




Chee Tayeb is a restaurant in Perth, Western Australia that serves a selection of authentic Lebanese cuisine. Below, you will find a few designs I have created for Chee Tayeb representing either an event or a promotional feature.



The design above demonstrates a flyer created for a live music lunch, featuring a local Oud player. The instrument in the middle is a Oud, a Middle Eastern instrument, design with calligraphic letter representing the Lebanese culture. The “ع”, also the “c” in “classical” is an Arabic letter (‘ayn) that has an unusual pronunciation. It is also the sound that starts at the beginning of the word “Oud.” The image in the background is a traditional Lebanese desert, Knafeh, made with cheese and syrup.

The drawing of the Oud was made using Adobe Photoshop, while the rest of the design was completed using Adobe Illustrator.



The above image is a sponsorship ad created to be placed in a Magazine. The ad represents the various selection of foods Chee Tayeb has to offer, including Manakeesh (cheese and thyme flat bread), pita bread, Hummus, meatballs, Halloumi cheese, fool (Vicia faba), Fatouch salad, and Knafeh.
